## **MINUTES**

# Board of Directors of the Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District January 11, 2023

# **CALL TO ORDER**

The Regular January meeting of the Board of Directors of the Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Taylor.

<u>ROLL CALL</u>: Directors Bohley, Duncan, Langle, Menna and Taylor were present. The Clerk of the Board/District Manager was also present.

PUBLIC COMMENT: No public were present.

<u>PRESENTATION</u>: Eric Outen, our Secure Pro technician gave a video presentation of our Secure Pro system. Summary:

- Hardware break-down by location: The cameras record motion and captures license plates. At 15 Vereda Leyenda there are four cameras, two on each side looking both directions. On Farren Road there are three cameras providing four views with one 360 degree multi view. All are powered by a battery back up.
- What does the system do?
  Scheduled snapshots twice daily that are uploaded to the Observables Portal.
  The IOBOT watches continuously. When motion occurs cameras begin recording continuously until motion stops.
- Motion clips are stored, generally for 90 days.
- Motion clips may be requested via the Observables Portal through user interface.
- As vehicles are identified, License Plate Recognition analyzes the clip and uploads the plate number with a corresponding snapshot to the Observables Portal.

<u>CAMERA POLICY</u>: The camera maintenance/use policy will be updated by the new Policies Committee to provide how to notify the Sheriff's Department for action to be taken.

MINUTES: The Board approved the December 14, 2022 regular meeting Minutes as edited on a motion made by Director Bohley, seconded by Director Menna, and passed (4-0), with Director Defoort abstaining.

<u>OATH OF OFFICE</u>: New Director Defoort took the Oath of Office and was Sworn in as Director of the Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District.
