CALL TO ORDER

The Special October meeting of the Board of Directors of the Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District was called to order at 7:30 PM by President Langle.

The final document will be submitted for Board approval at the November regular meeting.

The Finance Committee met on Monday, October 21, 2013 at which time the invoices, checks, bank balances, and account reconciliations were reviewed. Finance Officer, Bowman discussed income & expense reports, balance sheet, and budget to actual reports.

Finance Officer Bowman reported that the Finance Committee met with Harry Hagen, Santa Barbara County Auditor-Controller, to discuss EMID's investment options and strategies within the County Treasurer's Investment Pool, per EMID's Fiscal Management Policy.
