CALL TO ORDER

The regular August meeting of the Board of Directors of the Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District was called to order at 7:32 PM by President Langle.

• EMID/COUNTY JOINT MEETING:

Upon receipt of a letter from EMID regarding lack of response to questions from the community, Director and Deputy Director of Public Works spoke with staff via conference call. During that meeting EMID Community concerns regarding traffic, roads, flood control relating to roads and Tecolote creek, and the Whittier Fire were discussed. A "Town Meeting" was scheduled for October 4, 2017 at the EMID Community Center.
